The petitioner seeks relief of decision on its representation dated 16.5.2013 (Annexure P/11) and the application dated 26.9.2014 (Annexure P/12) with regard to grant of permanent recognition upto the middle class since temporary recognition upto 5th class had been granted.

Counsel for the petitioner at the out set submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent no.2 to decide the representation dated 16.5.2013 (Annexure P/11) and the application dated 26.9.2014 (Annexure P/12) within some time frame since the matter is pending consideration with the said respondent for more than a year.

It is further pointed out that the petitioner had also approached this Court in **Civil Writ Petition No.22836 of 2013** as petitioner no.8 which was decided on 15.1.2015 along with **CWP No.21269 of 2013--A.V.Public School and others Vs. State of Haryana and others**. In the said writ petition, the closure orders were under challenge and this Court had set aside the same and directed that the authorities would pass specific order against each of the schools by giving reasons why the institute would require to be closed. No such order had yet been passed and even the

application for granting permanent recognition remains pending consideration.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Saurabh Girdhar, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Copy of the writ petition has been supplied to him.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought by the petitioner, this Court is of the opinion that there is no requirement of receiving any reply on behalf of the State.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to take into consideration the said representation dated 16.5.2013 (Annexure P/11) and the application dated 26.9.2014 (Annexure P/12) and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case any adverse order is to be passed on the said issue or on the closure issue then a reasoned order be passed by the said respondent

The present writ petition is disposed off with the aforesaid directions.
