Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.2 to fix the date of actual hearing in an appeal titled as “Sukhdev Singh vs. Randhir Singh” pending before him and decide the same on merits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed an appeal along with stay application, which is pending before respondent no.2 – Superintending Canal Officer, Ferozepur Division, Ferozepur. Learned counsel further submits that appeal has been filed on 13.11.2014, but till date no date has been given to the petitioner nor the case has been fixed for preliminary hearing even.

In view of this, without giving notice to the respondents, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to fix the appeal filed by the petitioner and stay application, alleged to have been filed along with appeal, on an early date in the first week of March, 2015 and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law. The petitioner shall produce the copy of this order before respondent no.2.

Instant writ petition is disposed of with the above observations.
