In the present writ petition, the petitioner seeks the relief of declaration of the result for combined competitive (main) examination held in the month of July, 2014 for the post of Executive Branch in the Punjab State Civil Services in the category of Scheduled Caste (LDESM, Punjab).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner had applied under the said category and was having Roll No.4724298 and had qualified the preliminary examination held on 23.03.2014. Thereafter, he had appeared in the main exam in the month of July, 2014 against the four posts reserved and the result of the same had not been declared. He had made number of representations and also submitted a legal notice dated 01.12.2015 (Annexure P-6) with the respondents No.2 and 3, but no action has been taken on the same. He submits that he would be satisfied if a time-bound decision is taken by the said respondents.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. R.S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copy of the paper-book has been supplied to him.

Keeping in view the limited relief, this Court does not feel it necessary to call upon the respondents to file the reply. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, respondents No.2 and 3 are directed to take a decision on the representations made by the petitioner and inform the petitioner regarding the reason for the non-declaration of the result of the abovesaid main examination within a period of one month from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

However, it made clear that there is no such direction that, if the result has been withheld for any cogent reasons it has to be declared.

In view of above, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
