Father of the petitioner was working as Lineman with A.O.T.L., Batala, Sub Division, Batala. He expired on 25.04.2008 due to blood cancer. It is stated that before his death, the family incurred huge amount on his treatment. The petitioner has been representing to the respondents that he be granted compassionate appointment in terms of existing policy. However, without success.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 10.9.2012 (Annexure P-3).

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated dated 10.9.2012 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
