Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents to allow the petitioners to cultivate the land across the Indo-Pak border fencing, regarding which the petitioners have been issued board fencing gate pass by the Commandant, Border Security Force.

The petitioners claim that some of the persons are being allowed to cultivate the land across the Indo-Pak Border fencing, however, the petitioners are not being permitted to do the same and discrimination is being done by the authorities of the Border Security Force. The petitioners have not impleaded any person as a party to

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whom the authorities of Border Security Force have permitted to cultivate the land.

Being faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners wants to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file afresh with better particulars and after impleading all the relevant persons as parties.
