- 1.) Notice of motion.
- 2.) On our asking, Mr. Anil Mehta, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Since no order prejudicial to the interests of respondents is being passed, no reply is required from them.
- 3.) Let two copies of the writ petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day failing which this order shall be automatically recalled and the writ petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed for non-prosecution.
- 4.) The instant writ petition has been filed on the basis of an apprehension that the names of petitioners are likely to be shifted

from the voter list of Village Alipur to the voter list of Village Jahangirpur. The reliance is placed on ration cards, electricity bills and other official documents to contend that since the petitioners are *bona fide* residents of Village Alipur, the action of the official respondents to move them to village Jahangirpur is wholly unwarranted. We find from the records that such an issue has been raised by the petitioners vide their representations (P-1 and P-2). In this view of the matter it is not necessary to express any opinion on merits and we deem it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to respondent Nos.2 to 5 that while taking any decision with reference to the controversy noticed above, let the relevant documents and other material be kept in view and if necessary, the petitioner may be heard before taking the decision.
