Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in respect of the relief claimed in the present writ petition, a legal notice has been served by the petitioner upon respondent No.3 on 15.09.2014, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-3 with the petition.

She further submits that she would be satisfied, at this stage, if a direction is issued to the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice within a specified period.

Consequently, without going into the issue of maintainability of a writ petition against respondent No.5, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice, by passing a speaking order within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioner, or any part of it, is found due, the same shall be released to him, within a period of 2 months thereafter.

However, of course, if for any legally valid reason, the relief sought by the petitioner, or any part thereof, is not found due, such reasons for denial thereof, shall be given in the speaking order to be passed.
