This order shall dispose of four petitions bearing CWP Nos. 2783, 3794, 3860 and 3667 all of 2014. However, the facts are extracted from CWP No.2783 of 2014 (Zamila Vs. The State of Haryana and another).

Shorn of unnecessary details, it is pertinent to mention that tenure of the present panchayat is over, fresh elections have been ordered which are scheduled to be held somewhere in the month of February/March, 2016.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order passed against the petitioner would not debar her from contesting the election to the post of Panch or Sarpanch.

In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw these petitions as the same have become infructuous.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid observations.
