LISA GILL, J.

It is contended that petitioner, who is due to superannuate on 31.12.2015, has applied for extension in service in terms of notification dated 27.02.2013 (Annexure P-1) as well as 30.10.2015 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite representation dated 23.10.2015 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner no action is being taken thereon. At this stage, it is prayed that respondents be directed to decide said representation in a time bound manner and afford extension in service to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to competent authority to

expeditiously decide representation dated 23.10.2015 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of one month from receipt of certified copy of this order.
