DEEPAK SIBAL J. (ORAL)

On 30.11.2014, the petitioner retired as Deputy Collector from the Department of Irrigation, Government of Haryana but his retiral benefits were not released inspite of a legal notice having been served upon the respondents by the petitioner in this regard.

The present petition has been filed for release of the retiral benefits due to the petitioner, along with interest.

Learned counsel for the State of Haryana on written instructions from Sh. Ajender Suhag, Executive Engineer, RLI Water Services Division, Jhajjar, submits that the delay occurred due to the fact that the petitioner's pay fixation had not been done which on 18.12.2015 has now been done. He further submits that pay fixation of the petitioner having been done, his retiral dues will be paid to him within three months from today.

In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the State of Haryana, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

However, if on receipt of the released dues the petitioner is still dissatisfied, he would be at liberty to make a representation in this regard as also to claim interest thereupon to the respondents. The representation which may be made by the petitioner would be considered and decided expeditiously by the competent authority by passing a speaking order.
