**RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)**

The petitioner is relegated to pursue remedies before the Administrator. The petitioner is free to bring his grievance to the notice of the superior authorities of the exchange of correspondence between R-5 and R-6 so that his grievance can be looked into and redressed and his name entered in the seniority list as per law. In case the petitioner makes a representation, it is expected that the Administrator would pass a speaking order within two months from the date of the request. The petitioner would be heard and order will be passed informing him the reasons why his request has been accepted or rejected.

With the above observations, the petition stands disposed of.
