Challenge in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India inter alia is for quashing notification dated 15.1.2008 (Annexure P-3) issued under Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (in short “the Act”) followed by notification dated 14.1.2009 (Annexure P-6) issued under Section 6 of the Act and notice dated 14.12.2010 (Annexure P-6) issued under Section 9 of the Act.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition as inadvertently certain errors have crept in the writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action by furnishing better particulars. Learned counsel for the petitioners, however, states that

provisions of Section 24(2) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 are not attracted in the present case.

3. Challenge in this writ petition is only to the proceedings which culminated in award dated 12.1.2011.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. The question with regard to delay and laches will be considered at the time of hearing of the writ petition in the event of filing fresh petition.

5. Office to tag the records of CWP No. 2653 of 2015 with the fresh writ petition, if any, filed by the petitioners.
