Prayer in the present writ petition is for directing the respondents to give grace marks in one of the papers and in the alternative, a mercy chance, so that the petitioner can pass his Diploma in the Veterinary Livestock Development Assistant Course. The claim is based on the ground that similarly situated persons have been granted the same relief (Annexure P5).

Counsel submits that representation (Annexure P8) has already been made to the Vice Chancellor of respondent No.2. He submits that he would be satisfied if a decision is taken on the said representation, within a time-bound frame.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought, this Court does not feel it necessary to call upon the respondents to file reply.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2 to put up the case before the competent authority, who will take a decision on the representation (Annexure P8), as per rules and regulations, within a period of 4 weeks from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. If the relief is to be denied, a reasoned order be passed and the same be conveyed to the petitioner.
