The petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to count the military service rendered by the petitioner during Second National Emergency.

The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of their grievance, the petitioner has served a legal notice, Annexure P-4, however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without advertng to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide the legal notice, Annexure P-4, in the light of the judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.15678 of 2013, decided on 10.12.2013, captioned as Inderjit Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others, by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
