Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned notice (Annexure P/10) of respondent no.2.

The only apprehension of the petitioner is that some notice regarding vacation of premises has been pasted on the door of the premises, where he is residing.

This Court has no doubt that if the petitioner is to be evicted, the respondents shall proceed in accordance with law, not forcibly, specifically in view of civil court judgment.

Instant writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
