LISA GILL, J.

It is submitted that complete retiral benefits due to the petitioner have not been released despite petitioner having retired on 31.01.2015 by virtue of order dated 07.10.2015, Annexure P4. At this stage, it is prayed that respondents be directed to decide his representations dated 14.10.2015 Annexures P5 and 6, moved by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Keeping in view the limited prayer, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to

expeditiously decide representations dated 14.10.2015 Annexures P5 and P6, by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, any benefit is found due towards the petitioner, same be released within a period of six weeks thereafter.
