The prayer in the present writ petition is for quashing of letter dated 5.12.2014 (Annexure P-19) and further for a direction to respondent no. 1 to take back the petitioner in service in Haryana Civil Secretariat, where he had been initially working as Clerk from 15.10.1980.

It is not in dispute that on 5.12.1990 as a consequence of selection of the petitioner in the office of Commissioner, Gurgaon Division, Gurgaon, on transfer basis, he was relieved from his duties from the Haryana Civil Secretariat. It is specifically mentioned in the order that the lien of the petitioner shall not be retained in the Civil Secretariat. Thereafter, the petitioner again came back on the post of Steno-Typist in the Haryana Civil Secretariat as he was recruited on that post on transfer basis. Letter of appointment was issued on 11.10.1991. Again the petitioner was selected and appointed as Steno-Typist in the office of Deputy Commissioner, Gurgaon, on transfer basis on 28.5.2001. It has specifically been mentioned that the petitioner was not entitled to any benefit of previous service towards seniority, etc. The petitioner joined the new place of posting on 19.7.2001 and is working there as such.

Once the petitioner had been selected and appointed as Steno-Typist on transfer basis in the office of Deputy Commissioner, Gurgaon and his lien in the Haryana Civil Secretariat already stood terminated, the prayer made for taking him back in the Haryana Civil Secretariat cannot be accepted at this stage after more than a decade.

The writ petition is dismissed.
