Admittedly, the petitioner vide letter dated 27.12.1991 applied for voluntary retirement whereby his resignation was accepted w.e.f. 16.01.1992 on 03.03.2000 (Annexure P-6). A period of more than one and half decades has gone by and the petitioner has slept over his legal rights. The bar of limitation has crept in and at this stage, he is estopped from raising any challenge.

It would thus, not be appropriate for this Court to exercise jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.
