MAHESH GROVER.J.

On 17.3.2015, the Court had directed the petitioner to place on record certain documents which would show him to be senior to some of the persons who have already been promoted. But he has not complied with the aforesaid direction. The Court is of the view that unless seniority list is perused, the cause of affected persons cannot be established. The petitioner concedes that he has applied for the seniority list which is not with him. If that is so, then I am of the view that the instant petition is half-baked and the court is unable to appreciate the grievance of the petitioner. The petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh and comprehensive one on the cause of action espoused herein.
