Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that the entire amount of interest on account of delayed disbursement of retiral dues has been paid to the petitioner.

The aforesaid fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner. He further stated that no further claim is pending. As far as taking care of delay in disbursement of retiral dues to the employees, it has been stated in the affidavit that all the offices have been called upon to compile the data of the employees who had to retire in next six months so as to finalize their retiral dues and further that in case there is any delay, strict disciplinary action should be taken against the officials concerned and even the interest/penalty on delayed payment of retiral dues shall be recovered from them.

As the claim of the petitioner in the present petition has been satisfied, nothing survives therein and the same is disposed of.
