On 23.12.2015, learned counsel for the petitioner had sought time to produce a demand draft of ₹ 25/- lakhs drawn in favour of the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court to show bona fides of the petitioner but today he has expressed his inability to do so. The intention of the petitioner in approaching this Court does not appear to be bonafide.

2. Thus, no ground for exercise of writ jurisdiction under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is made out. The writ petition is dismissed.
