- 1.) Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 4 only at this stage.
- 2.) On our asking, Mr. K.K. Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on their behalf.
- 3.) Let four copies of the writ petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day failing which this order shall be automatically recalled and the writ petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed for non-prosecution.
- 4.) The grievance of the petitioner in the instant writ petition is that eviction order under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common

Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 was passed against 15 persons only but in purported execution thereof notices have been served on 24 persons including the petitioner for removal of the alleged encroachment. The petitioner submits that in the absence of any eviction order against him, warrants issued by the Assistant Collector, Ist Grade are wholly unwarranted.

5.) Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction that the instant writ petition may be treated as objections on behalf of the petitioner and respondent No.3 shall firstly consider and decide these objections by passing a reasoned order, before taking any action to dispossess the petitioner.

6.) A copy of this order by given to Mr. K.K. Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab for information and necessary compliance.
