After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the record, this Court has come to the conclusion that the order passed by the C.C.O is not in conformity with the principle of natural justice as he has not discussed the arguments raised by the petitioners in the order and has rather copied the order passed by the S.C.O.

Learned counsel for the respondents has failed to support the order of the C.C.O.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. The order passed by the C. C.O is set aside and the matter is remanded back to him to decide it afresh after taking into consideration the respective arguments raised by both the learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the respondents, at this stage, prays that the C.C.O may be directed to take the decision as expeditiously as possible.

In view thereof, the C.C.O is directed to decide the matter as soon as possible, preferably within a period of two months from the date of appearance of the parties before him.

The parties are directed to appear before the C.C.O on 23.12.2015.
