Instant writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing notice issued vide memo No.4283 dated 10.12.2009 (Annexure P-1) and notice dated 17.01.2014 (Annexure P-8) whereby demand of ₹ 71,159/- and ₹ 35,579/-, respectively, has been raised by respondents on account of alleged theft of electricity by the petitioner.

Present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail the remedy as provided under Sections 135 to 140 of the Indian Electricity Act. Since petitioner has already deposited 50% of the amount, its connection shall not be disconnected for one month from

today. In case petitioner avails the remedy in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Electricity Act and moves appropriate petition, same shall be heard on merit instead of technical objection of limitation as the petitioner has been availing the remedies before wrong forums under bona fide belief, including filing of writ petition before this Court.
