Submits that the petitioner had retired on 28.02.2015 and is seeking consideration on account of her seniority for the notional benefits.

However, a perusal of the paper-book does not show that any such application has been filed before the respondents, after retirement depicting as to how she is entitled and whether any junior had been granted the said benefits.

In such circumstances, counsel for the petitioner submits that he would file appropriate representation/legal notice before the authorities concerned for redressal of his grievances.

Needless to say that it is expected that the respondent/State shall decide the said representation within a period of 3 months from the receipt of the same.
