The instant writ petition is directed against the order dated 3.8.2015 passed by Collector, Rupnagar which is appealable before the Commissioner-cum-Appellate Authority under the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961. The petitioner is, accordingly, relegated to the above stated alternative remedy. It is, however, directed in the interest of justice that in case the appeal is filed within one month from today, the same shall be entertained on merits and shall not be rejected on the ground of limitation. Further ***status quo*** is directed to be maintained for a period of one month to enable the petitioner to file appeal.
