The petitioner-Society claims that notwithstanding the State Government's order holds it entitled to, the mutation of subject plot in its favour has been cancelled at the directions of the Deputy Commissioner.

2.) In our considered view, if there is an adjudication by the State Government in favour of the petitioner, the appropriate recourse for the petitioner-Society would be to approach the State Government against the action of the Deputy Commissioner. We have no reason to doubt that in the event of any appeal-cum-representation by the petitioner-Society, the State Government shall consider and decide the same, in accordance with law, preferably within one month.
