This Civil Writ Petition has been filed, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for quashing of impugned order dated 24.05.2011 (Annexure P-6) whereby it has been observed that Monthly Financial Assistance under rules, 2006 shall be paid only after 7 years from the date the husband of the petitioner has gone missing, for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the Monthly Financial Assistance, family pension and all consequential benefits along with interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish the requisite undertaking in terms of Annexure P-9 (Instructions for welfare of the family of the missing employee).

Learned State counsel contends that in case the husband of the petitioner appears, the beneficiary will have to refund the entire payment along with interest.

Heard.

In view of above statement, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case the petitioner files a requisite undertaking, in terms of Annexure P-9, within 45 days from the receipt of a certified copy of this order, all consequential benefits under the scheme be released to the petitioner within three months thereafter.
