The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release GPF amount alongwith interest as the petitioner retired on 30.06.2012.

Notice of motion was issued on 08.01.2015 and in response thereto, short reply by way of an affidavit of Chief Engineer, Guru Gobind Singh Thermal Plant, Rupnagar on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 has been filed which is already on record.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the necessary payment has been released to the petitioner along with interest and nothing remains to be paid to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the submission made by learned counsel for respondent No.2.

In view of submission made by learned counsel for respondent No.2, the present petition has become infructuous.
