Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to issue/renew Arms Licence No. 6851-DM-SSA double barrel gun.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has sent a legal notice dated 01.11.2015 (Annexure P/5) for compliance of order dated 16.10.2014 (Annexure P/4) passed by Commissioner, Hisar Division, (Camp at Sirsa) to the District Magistrate, Sirsa, but no decision has been taken thereon.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after

perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of, without issuing notice to the respondents, with a direction to the District Magistrate, Sirsa, to take a decision on the legal notice (Annexure P/5) sent by the petitioner in view of remand order dated 16.10.2014 passed by the Commissioner, Hisar Division, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and copy of the order so passed shall be communicated to the petitioner.
