Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 7 for removing illegal encroachment and unlawful obstruction on the roads/phirni/internal road and Government land in village Kajheri (opposite ISBT-43).

In compliance of order dated 27.08.2015, status report has been filed alongwith photographs (Annexure R-1) which is taken on record. It is mentioned in the report that on 18.11.2015, the field

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staff/Patwari visited the spot and no encroachment/kabari was found at the time of inspection. In view of above, instant petition has become infructuous.

Otherwise also, none appeared on behalf of the petitioners on 03.03.2015, 10.07.2015 and 27.08.2015.

Even today, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
