On our asking, Ms. Kirti Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice.

Keeping in view the nature of order which we propose to pass, there is no necessity to seek reply of the respondents.

The Sub Divisional Officer[Civil], Gurgaon has passed a well reasoned speaking order in compliance to the directions issued by this order on 25.08.2015 in CWP No. 10654 of 2015.

The petitioners have again come forward with a series of documents to contend that they are *bona-fide* residents of village Chandu, , District Gurgaon and can not be shifted to village Budhera.

In our considered view, such a factual plea raised by the petitioners can be effectively gone into by the respondent – authorities.

Consequently, we dispose of this writ petition relegating the petitioners to the District Election Officer-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Gurgaon who may look into the petitioners' grievance, in accordance with law, well before the Gram Panchayat's elections are held.
