Pursuant to the order dated 03.07.2015 learned counsel for the Insurance Company has brought two cheques; one bearing No. 684463 dated 22.07.2015 of HDFC Bank in the sum of ₹4,44,000/- in the name of appellant No.1-Reena Devi w/o Sh. Kamal Singh and another bearing No. 684464 dated 22.07.2015 of HDFC Bank in the sum of ₹2,50,000/- in the name of appellant No.3-Karan Singh (minor) s/o Sh. Kamal Singh.

Learned counsel for the Insurance Company has further stated that in terms of the order dated 03.07.2015 a cheque of HDFC Bank bearing No. 684419 dated 22.7.2015 for an amount of ₹56,000/- has been made in the name of MACT Bathinda as share of respondent No.5-Ram Piari, mother of the deceased (photo-copy placed on record) and the same has been deposited at MACT, Bathinda.

Let Reena Devi deposit the abovesaid cheque bearing No. 684464 dated 22.07.2015 of HDFC Bank of ₹2,50,000/- in State Bank of Patiala, High Court Branch, Chandigarh for issuing an FDR in the name of minor Karan Singh s/o Kamal Singh through his mother Reena Devi w/o Sh. Kamal Singh for a period till Karan Singh attains the age of majority and the said FDR be delivered

to appellant No.1-Reena Devi.

The cheque in the sum of ₹4,44,000/- in the name of appellant No.1-Reena Devi has been handed over to her.

In view of the above, the appeal stands disposed of as settled.

Copy of the order be supplied to learned counsel for the parties. A copy of this order be also supplied to the Manager, State Bank of Patiala, High Court Branch, Chandigarh for compliance and file be returned to the High Court.
