Present writ petition is directed against the impugned transfer order dated 24.12.2014 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent no.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that he does not intend to press this petition for a writ in the nature of Certiorari, for the time being. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, if respondent no.2 is directed to consider the grievance of the petitioner, raised vide his representation dated 30.12.2014 (Annexure P-4), which is pending decision.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Director General, Health Services, Haryana, Sector 6, Panchkula-respondent no.2 is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioner, which prima facie seems to be genuine, as raised vide

his representation dated 30.12.2014 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
