In this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to correct the Wards and house numbers of the petitioners in the voter list (Annexures P-3 and P-4) and their votes be made in Sangat Mandi Ward No.8 where they actually reside as per ration card of petitioners No.1 and 2 (Annexure P-1) and pension card (Annexure P-2) of petitioner No.3.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that for the relief claimed in the writ petition, petitioner No.1 had moved an application dated 9.2.2015 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.4 but no action has so far been taken thereon.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, perusing the present petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we dispose of the present petition by directing respondent No.4 to decide the application dated 9.2.2015 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners by 23.2.2015 for which they will appear before him on 20.2.2015.
