RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that before filing the present writ petition, petitioner served respondent No.1 through a self-contained legal notice dated 16.10.2014 but the same could not be placed on record with this petition only because of inadvertence on his part. He submits that the legal notice dated 16.10.2014 is pending decision before respondent No.1 and petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.1 is directed to consider and decide his legal notice, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Administrator/Manager, the Ambala Central Cooperative Consumers Store Limited, Chandigarh-respondent No.1, is

directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioner raised vide his legal notice dated 16.10.2014 and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
