Application is for placing on record office order dated 15.10.2015 as Annexure R-1. Same is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Application is disposed of.

Civil Writ Petition No. 4186 of 2014 (O&M)

Prayer in this writ petition is for taking into account the service rendered by the petitioner in the erstwhile Punjab State Electricity Board and quashing the condition in order dated 19.11.2008 that if the petitioner joins Punjab University and any other institution, the Board will not release his pension contribution/leave salary contribution. Petitioner joined Punjab State Electricity Board

(Now Punjab State Power Corporation Limited) as Apprentice

Revenue Accountant on 25.01.2000. He was posted as Revenue Accountant on regular basis on 13.12.2000. He continued working as such up to 10.03.2004 when he was appointed to the post of Accounts Officer by the Board.

Pursuant to his application for appointment to the post of Finance and Development Officer with the Panjab University, Chandigarh, he was selected and appointed on 19.11.2008. Petitioner submitted his resignation, which was accepted by the Board, however, respondent-Board refused to release his pension contribution, leave salary contribution etc. for the period of service rendered by him with the Board.

Learned counsel for the respondents, while referring to Annexure R-1 dated 15.10.2015, submits that necessary relief as claimed by the petitioner has been afforded rendering this writ petition infructuous. Respondent-Corporation would pay proportionate pensionary liability calculated as per instructions prevailing at the time of superannuation of the petitioner by his existing department. It is further submitted that necessary action for release/deposit of the said amount with the Panjab University shall be taken within a period of two months.

In view of above, present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
