Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to provide a mercy chance to the petitioner for one subject, namely, Advance Nursing Practice of M.Sc. Nursing 1st year course.

In the written statement filed, the plea taken by the respondent-University is that only three attempts can be permitted and a candidate failing in more than two subjects will not be promoted to the second year.

In the absence of any such statutory provision and once the maximum number of attempts is fixed at three which the petitioner has admittedly availed, there is no scope for issuing a direction that petitioner be given a chance to sit in any mercy examination.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
