The petitioners had challenged the allotment in favour of one Ram Kumar, who is respondent no.6 on the ground that he had been allotted two plots.

Learned counsel appearing for the Housing Board, Haryana states that the allotment of the second plot has been cancelled.

In view thereof, the petitioners' grievance stands redressed.

Further prayer made in the petition is to stop the allotment of more than one plot under the BPL Scheme to each person. Learned counsel appearing for the Housing Board informs that the policy of the Govt. is not to allot more than one plot to a person. The statement is accepted.

If the petitioners have any grievance regarding any other party having been allotted more than one plot or if they intend filing a P.I.L, they are always at liberty to adopt appropriate proceedings.
