more opportunity was granted. However, the petitioners having failed to do so, final demolition notice under Section 246 of the Punjab Municipal Corporation Act, 1976 was served.

2. The aggrieved petitioners have approached this Court.

3. With a view to enable the petitioners to produce the proof of ownership or their lawful possession, this Court stayed the demolition proceedings and adjourned the case, so that the relevant documents could be produced.

4. Sufficient opportunities have already been granted to the petitioners. It appears that the petitioners are not coming forward to give instructions to their learned counsel also.

5. In these circumstances when petitioners are not coming forward to comply with previous orders and action has been taken with a view to implement the time bound directions, issued by this Court, we dismiss the petition for non-prosecution.

6. Dismiss for non-prosecution.
