AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The claim in the present petition is to grant minimum revised pay scale of Rs.7510/- + Grade Pay of Rs.2400/- w.e.f. 01.01.2006 in view of the recommendations of the 6th Pay Commission and also to grant the MACP in Pay Band-2 in the pay scale of Rs.9300-34800 + Grade Pay of Rs.4200/- along with all consequential benefits including arrears of the revised pay scale and MACP with interest @ 18% per annum w.e.f. the due date i.e. 26.11.2008.

Learned counsel states that in this regard the petitioner has also moved a Legal Notice dated 02.07.2014 (Annexure P-9) and that he would be satisfied at this stage if in the first instance a direction is issued to the

respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Resultantly, the respondent No.2 is directed to decide the said legal notice by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the petitioner is found entitled to any benefit the same be released to him within a period of one month thereafter. It is made clear that in case any due relief is not granted to the petitioner within the aforesaid period the petitioner would be entitled to claim the same with interest @ 8% p.a. from the date/s the amount/s fell due till payment/s.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
