Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the pensionary benefits of the mother of the petitioners including pension from 01.12.2014 till 09.01.2015, who retired from the service of respondent no.4 on 30.11.2014.

The mother of the petitioners, namely, Smt. Bimla, was a Safai Sewak in the Municipal Council, Dhariwal. She joined the abovesaid Class IV post on 23.09.1981 and retired on 30.11.2014. The mother of the petitioners has expired on 09.01.2015. The pensionary benefits of the mother of the petitioners have not been paid. The petitioners have approached this Court after representing the respondents to which no

response has been received till date.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after perusing the paper-book, however, without giving notice to the respondents, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Executive Officer of the Municipal Council, Dhariwal to get all the pension papers of the mother of the petitioners completed, if so required after visiting the petitioners within seven days and release the due amount payable by the Municipal Council, Dhariwal within seven days thereafter. The pension papers complete in all respects shall be handed over to the concerned office through a special messenger the very next day of completion of those papers and respondents shall release the due amount of pension along with arrears within three weeks from the date of submission of the papers. In case, the petitioners are not paid the due amount before 08.04.2015, there shall be cost of Rs.200/- per day on the Executive Officer of the Municipal Council, Dhariwal which shall be personally recoverable from him and in that event the petitioners shall also become entitled for interest 9% per annum.
