RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

The only argument raised against the transfer is that the transfer was made when the model code of conduct was in force in the ensuing municipal elections in the State of Punjab.

I do not find any ground to interfere in the transfer order without there being anything else imputed against the transfer such as violation of the transfer policy on which interference may be called for, or malafides or perversity in its making on administrative grounds.

Interference is not warranted.

The petition to stand dismissed.
