1. The petitioner's grievance is that an amount of ₹2,88,000/- which is payable by the respondents for having completed the work has not been paid. The petitioner has already sent a representation in that regard. The representation shall be considered and if it results in admission of liability, there shall be an endeavour to make the payment within the period as it is possible and if it does not result in fruitful action of realization of amount, the petitioner will resort to a proper action by institution of a civil suit and recover the same under Order 10 CPC, if there is admission of liability. It must be remembered by the State authority that there could be no discrimination in making payments by making it to some contractors and denying to some, who are similarly situated.

2. The writ petition stands disposed of as above.
