Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent nos.2 to 4 for releasing of adequate water in the irrigation tail canal no. 33800 and 38800, leading to Village Behman Kaur Singh to the fields of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to file a detailed representation to the Department mentioning all the facts including the total cultural command area and for how much the area water has been sanctioned.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty. If such representation is filed, same shall be decided within a period of two months from the date of filing of representation.
