Rajesh Bindal, J.

The petitioner herein, who was an applicant for the post of JBT Teacher in pursuance to the Advertisement No. 4/93 published on 22.8.1993, has filed the present petition seeking a direction to the official respondents to offer her appointment in terms of her merit position.

Earlier the petitioner had filed CWP No. 15485 of 1995 – Nahani Devi and others vs the State of Haryana and others in this Court, which was dismissed by this Court on 23.8.2013 in terms of the detailed judgment in CWP No. 17551 of 1999 Reeta Bansal vs State of Haryana and others, decided on 19.12.2011, as the selection process already stood completed.

The present petition has been filed by placing reliance upon a reply given by the official respondents to the application moved by the petitioner under the Right to Information Act wherein it has been stated that all posts advertised in the year 1993 were not filled up. It is sought to be claimed that as per information received, the selection process is still continuing. The contention is totally misconceived. Merely because some of the posts advertised had not been filled up on account of various reasons including non availability of suitable candidates, it cannot be said that after more than 20 years the selection process in pursuance to the advertisement dated 22.8.1993 was still continuing when even after that there had been number of selections of JBT Teachers.

The writ petition is dismissed.
