RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the order dated 29.10.2013 passed by this Court in CWP No. 1518 of 2013 Annexure P4 (Dharampal v. Managing Director, UHBVNL, Panchkula and others). He further submits that given an opportunity, petitioner shall approach respondent no.1, who is the competent authority, by moving an appropriate representation within a period of six weeks' from today and he may be directed to consider the same within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Managing Director, UHBVNL – respondent no.1 is directed that if the petitioner approaches him by moving an appropriate representation within a period of six weeks from today, he shall consider and decide the same at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of representation from the petitioner.

While considering the claim of the petitioner, respondent no.1 shall also keep in mind the order dated 29.10.2013, passed by this Court in CWP-1518 of 2013 (Annexure P4).

With the above said observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
