This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to the respondents to release all the retiral benefits and other arrears which are due to the petitioner from the date of retirement of the petitioner i.e. 30.04.2013 along with interest @18% per annum from the date of retirement till these are actually paid.

Reply on behalf of respondent Nos.3 and 4 filed in the Court, is taken on record.

Learned State counsel informs that all the benefits have been released to the petitioner. This fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that all the benefits have been

granted to the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition. However, he submits that interest on the delayed payment has not been granted.

In these circumstances, petition shall submit a representation for interest on the delayed payment to the competent authority within three months after the receipt of certified copy of this order and competent authority is directed to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon, within three months of receiving the said representation, in the light of judgment **The Financial Commissioner and Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Irrigation Department, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh Vs. Hasan Singh Kanwar**, passed in LPA No. 915 of 2009.
