MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays that a writ in the nature of mandamus be issued directing the respondents to re-advertise the posts incorporating a degree of M.Sc. Dairy Technology as an equivalent eligibility condition. This prayer of the petitioner stems from Annexure P-4, a judgment rendered by this Court where the petitioner therein had been excluded from the process of selection on the ground that he did not possess the requisite qualification prescribed in the advertisement namely B.Sc. Dairy Husbandry, B.Sc. Dairy Technology or B.Tech. Dairy Technology. In that case the petitioner had contended that he was M.Sc. Dairy Technology and therefore it should be construed to be a better qualification than B.Sc. Dairy Technology. This Court while accepting the plea had directed the respondents to consider

the grievance of the petitioner in the said writ petition by deciding his representation.

The petitioner, however, was not even an applicant to the process of selection and thus no parity of reasoning can be afforded to him to grant any prayer as raised in the petition more particularly when this Court would not be empowered to issue a mandamus directing the respondents to formulate an advertisement in a particular way.

No ground to interfere. Dismissed.

The petitioner would be at liberty to pursue his remedy with the respondents.
