Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the action of the respondents in not considering and granting the petitioner his due promotion on the post of Lecturer as allowed to his juniors.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already moved a representation dated 07.10.2014 (Annexure P/9), but no action has been taken thereon. Learned counsel confines his prayer for a direction to respondent No.1 – Chairperson, Punjab School Education Board, Mohali, to decide his representation within a time-framed period.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after

perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case and without giving notice to the respondents, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-Chairperson, Punjab School Education Board, Mohali, to look into the grievance of the petitioner specifically made in the representation (Annexure P/9) and pass an appropriate order thereon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
